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Landscape analysis focus and purpose

- Landscape analysis focused on water, health, and equity, included interviews and literature review.
- Examined key challenges to establishing integrated systems for stormwater, groundwater, and drinking water as the key to resilience.
- Advanced a strategic framework for outreach, engagement, and advocacy for future water infrastructure investments.

- 1. Cultivate a new narrative that links all aspects of water
- 2. Incorporate health equity provisions into future funding measures
- 3. Support innovative policy and system change solutions using local authority



Recommendations (cont.)

- Invest in community capacity to address water-related health inequities
- 5. Formalize collaboration among agencies, academics, non-profit leaders, and other stakeholders



Recommendations (cont.)

- 7. Expand and enhance the role of public health in regional water efforts
- 8. Develop a peer learning/strategy network among mainstream environmental groups and CBOs

 Improve data collection, research, and documentation of water-related health inequities, especially through participatory action research
